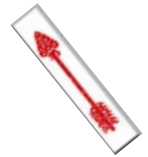

PAGE 1 The Adult Leader is to key in everything from Date of Election through Number of Youth Actively Registered in your unit. Skip down and key in the Adult Leader information.

A Letter of Verification including a listing of all Youth elected or Adults approved will be sent to each unit within two weeks after the end of unit elections to be used as Call-Out verification.

NOTE: The Lodge will notify all Candidates of their Election and opportunities for Induction after the final day of Bear Creek Summer Camp.

PAGE 2 Key in all information for each Nominee from First Name through Zip Code. Please record the name exactly as it appears on your Unit Charter Roster with middle initial.

PAGE 3 First and Last names keyed in on Page 2 automatically drop to each of the two ballots on Page 3. The Unit Leader is to distribute one ballot to each voter. The Unit Election Team will collect, count and record the marked ballots. The Unit Election Team is responsible for the destruction of the marked ballots.

Print out three (3) copies of Page 1 and Page 2 for the Election Team. Click the Print button on Page 1. On the Print Screen, you may select Number of Copies and the pages you wish to print.

Order of the Arrow Unit Elections are authorized for Boy Scout Troops and Varsity Teams only

Your unit election must be conducted by an authorized Unit Election Team consisting of at least one member from outside your unit and must be conducted within the council where your unit is chartered

Please note that only one unit may be recorded on a single form – a Boy Scout Troop and a Varsity Team meeting together is two separately chartered units and each must have their own election and election report

All OA Unit Elections must be conducted during the time of year established by our Lodge

Youth Eligibility requirements:

1. Currently **registered** in your unit
2. Hold the **First Class** rank or higher
3. After registering with a Boy Scout Troop or Varsity Scout Team, have experienced **15 days and nights** of Boy Scout camping during the two-year period immediately prior to the election. The 15 days and nights must include one, but no more than one, long-term camp consisting of **SIX** consecutive days and **FIVE** nights of resident camping, approved and under the auspices and standards of the Boy Scouts of America. The balance (10 nights) of the camping must be overnight, weekend, or other short-term camps. Campouts less than five nights are considered short-term.

All reports are to be returned to the Chapter Adviser within 3 days following the election
