	Instructor Level 2 or Director – Hover-mode – Supervising, watching for potential problems, assists in
	short bursts, makes final decisions, handles emergency.
	Instructor Level 1 – Flat wall climb belay station
	Instructor Level 1 – Angled wall climb belay station
	Instructor Level 1 – Rappel belay station
	Instructor Level 1 or 2 – On top to rig kids for rappel
	Instructor Level 1 - Medical/Hold harmless papers; Safety/Participant Briefing; dressing harnesses &
	helmets. Reference <b>Participant Safety Brief</b>
	Instructor Extra Lev 1 – Rig the practice table & run practice rappelling with participants.
	Medical – One Person (does not have to be instructor) with current CPR & First Aid Cert
	Troop Adults/Parents –
	- 1 Adult leader always present in case of emergency.
	- Help with practice table.
	- Help with harnessing female to female, male to male.
	- Competent, known, & trained – can help with belaying (rappel belay station)
	Scouts – Backup belayers. Practice table spotters.
	Gear
	Keys to gear & ladders in COPE shed. Combo is ****. Level 2 or Director has combo.
	Start Tower Log w/ Tower Event Report names of instructors
	Check Out - Open tower binder & use <b>Gear Inventory</b> sheet. <b>Skip a line &amp; write "Check Out"</b> for all
	gear you use today. Note any missing items. Rocks exempt from checkout.
	Check Out -Harnesses & Helmets for needs of the day and recorded in gear log.
	Rigging
	Top – Instructor cable ascends to the top with: tether, pulley, carabiners, & 1 rope
	Top – Instructor on top drops rope & assisting instructor on bottom hooks in gear to send up carabiners,
	rappel 8's, tethers, gloves, & eventually rope up to top
	Top – 1 pulley per side, ~2 tethers per side, releasable munter-mule on big eyelet, drop belay ropes on
	each side, drop rappel rope
	Belay Stations - Use large webbing to tie in & attach ATCs. Thread belay ropes when Top drops them
	Bottom - Get ladders out of COPE shed & screw rocks into walls
	Practice Table – Rig munter-mule, rappel rope, belay rope to a truck or tie yourself into the system
	Tractice ruble ring marker mate, rupperrope, being rope to a track of the yourself into the system
	Emergency Prep
	Lev 2 or Director briefs everyone with McGimsey Tower Emergency Plan
	Inspect tower for any broken cables, boards, poles, or other damage
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	Clean un
	Clean up
	Use <b>Gear Inventory</b> sheet & on a new line write "Check In". Works best with 2 people. Note any
	missing/damaged items. Inform Lev 2 or Director.
	Instructor that inspected rope fills out rope corresponding log
	Put gear back in sheds & make sure locks are actually locked. (It's happened before)
]	Debrief with <b>McGimsey Tower Event Report</b> filled out. Tracks instructor certs, improvements etc
