Safety Moment

Animal and Insect Hazards

- Mosquitos, ticks, mammals, and other creatures can spread disease
- Know the area you will be visiting
- Is it wooded? Near a swamp? Known to have a high population of deer, raccoons, or bats?
- Encourage and teach avoidance of all wild animals
- Bring repellents and netting
- Set good policy around checking for ticks and bites
- Make sure repellents are used and reapplied
