Hazardous Trees

- A hazardous tree poses a risk of falling or dropping limbs due to disease, structural defects, environmental stress or other conditions.
- Each year, falling trees and limbs cause serious injuries, fatalities, and significant property damage.
- More likely to drop limbs or fall suddenly, especially during high winds or storms, but can happen at any time.
- During pre-event checks & daily walk-throughs, look for common red flags:
 - Dead or dying limbs or sections of the trunk;
 - Large cracks or splits in branches or trunk
 - Broken or hanging limbs, known as "widow-makers"

Commissioner's Minute

Safeguarding Youth is now live

- This training is required for all registered adult volunteers and is also a
 joining requirement for all new adult members.
- The course takes approximately 90 minutes and is available in English and Spanish.
- Volunteers must take a 15-minute annual refresher course and pass a retest each year to remain compliant.
- YPT certifications remain valid until expiration or one year from the launch of the new training, whichever is shorter.
- This update is part of Scouting America's continued commitment to youth protection, emphasizing active supervision, situational awareness, and a safety culture.


