Many Scouters (Pack, Troop, Crew and Ship adult leaders) have a tremendous impact upon Scouting in their neighborhoods and units but may not be well recognized throughout the Council. Their work is very important and has a direct effect on the quality of Scouting in the the Alamo Area Council. This award is an attempt to properly recognize individuals who have excelled in serving youth on a unit level.

Any member of the unit (parent or registered adult leader) who is knowledgeable about the nominee's Scouting record can nominate an individual. Self-nominations will not be accepted. This award is primarily for service within/to a unit. Scouters who perform exemplary service to the District and/or community are recognized by the District Award of Merit.

To be considered for this award the nominee must meet the following criteria:

• Nominee must be currently registered and active in Scouting.

I nominate the following individual for the LEAD:

- Nominee must have completed the training appropriate for their registered position.
- Nominee has contributed to making Scouting America's program where they serve better.
- Nominee should follow and promote Scouting America's principles and guidelines.
- Nominee should set an example for other Scouting America leaders to follow.
